Virtual Classroom Program Information

- There are two virtual classroom programs: Immigration and Vikings & Norse Mythology
- Vikings & Norse mythology
 - This program introduces your students to the main characters in Norse Mythology. During the program, we'll learn about the major Norse gods and goddesses and listen to a Norse myth together. Finally, we'll explore the people who worshipped these gods--the Vikings. This program includes a closer look at Viking-age objects in the Museum's collections. (One 45-minute class period, best for grades 1-4)
- Nordic Immigration
 - This two-part program will introduce your students to Nordic Immigration and traditions of Nordic America. In the first session, students will learn what brought Nordic people to the U.S., what they brought with them, and where they chose to live once they arrived. The second session includes a close look at objects brought to the U.S. by Nordic immigrants and a discussion of the traditions in Nordic America today. (Two 45-minute class periods, best for grades 4-7)
- The cost of these programs is \$25 for up to classes of 20 students. For over 20 students, the cost is \$50.
