



Teacher Advisory Committee—2021-2023 Application

The National Nordic Museum seeks to form a Teacher Advisory Committee that will inform the development of the Museum's educational resources and programs. The Committee will include both primary and secondary school educators from throughout Washington state.

Educators can serve on this committee for a period of two years, with the option of a one-year extension. Meetings will be conducted semi-annually via a teleconferencing platform. The teacher advisory committee advises and supports the National Nordic Museum's education & programs team in the development and promotion of resources and programs for K-12 students and teachers.

Role:

- Identify topics and subjects of interest for teacher workshops, classroom programs, and curriculum resources.
- Share first-hand experiences with museum staff regarding contemporary issues in the education field.
- Provide feedback, assessment, and evaluation on museum programs to ensure relevance to classroom curriculum.
- Act as a Museum ambassador in their schools by disseminating information to colleagues and providing teacher feedback to Museum educators.

Responsibilities:

- Committee members serve a two-year term, with the option of a one-year extension.
- Committee members are required to attend semi-annual meetings, hosted on a teleconferencing platform (Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Google Meet).
- Must be available for free, one-hour pilot workshops in their classroom or at the Museum at least once a year.
