Virtual Classroom Program Information

- There are 2 different program options you can choose from:
 - Vikings & Norse Mythology: one 45-minute lesson, works best for grades 1-4
 - This program introduces your students to the main characters in Norse Mythology. During the program, we'll learn about the major Norse gods and goddesses and listen to a Norse myth together. Finally, we'll explore the people who worshipped these gods--the Vikings. This program includes a closer look at Viking-age objects in the Museum's collections
 - Nordic Immigration: two 45-minute lessons, works best for grades 4-7
 - This two-part program will introduce your students to Nordic Immigration and traditions of Nordic America. In the first session, students will learn what brought Nordic people to the U.S., what they brought with them, and where they chose to live once they arrived. The second session includes a close look at objects brought to the U.S. by Nordic immigrants and a discussion of the traditions in Nordic America today
- These programs are designed to be facilitated virtually, via Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Google Meet
