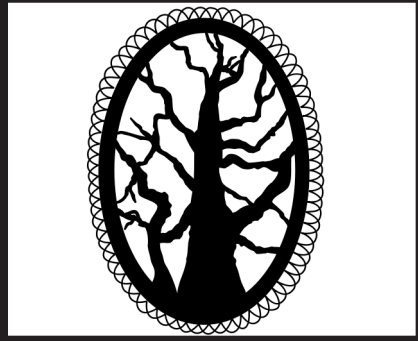


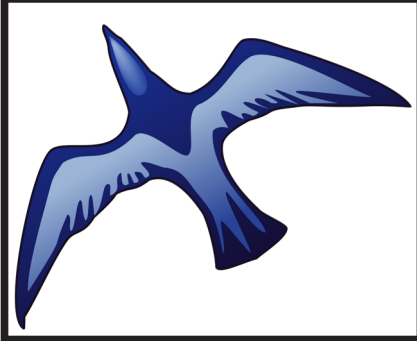

Discuss what you see as you explore.

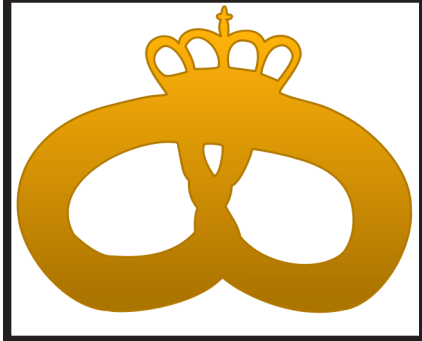
What stories do you see between the branches?



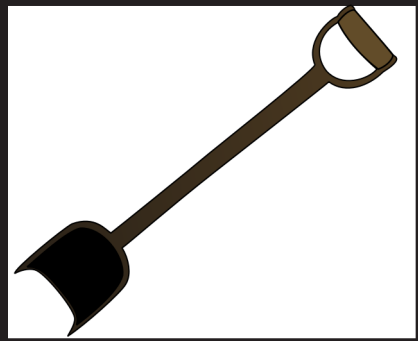
They are flying between bridges that connect to two lands.



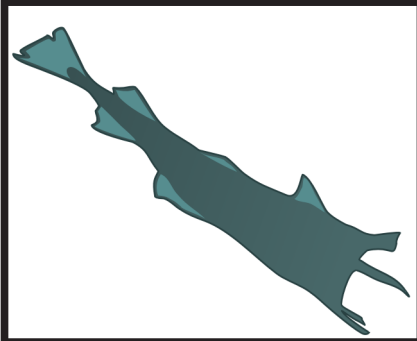
From what kind of business is this sign from?

This belonged to someone who loved the outdoors. How do you connect with nature?



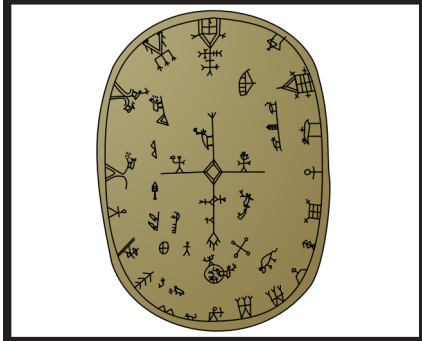
Is this a toy, a work of art, or both?

He sacrificed an eye for knowledge. Who is he?



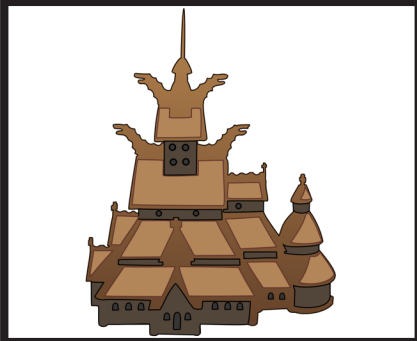
A life-sized replica of a figure-head of a Viking ship. Why do you think is carved like a snake?



Why would a raven be on a Viking ship?



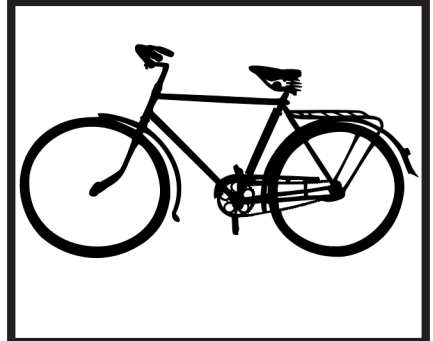
What characteristics do you see on this church?



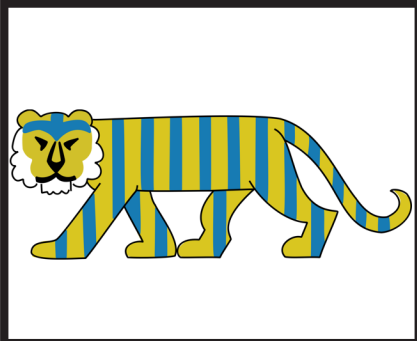
If you had to leave everything behind, what would you pack in one trunk?



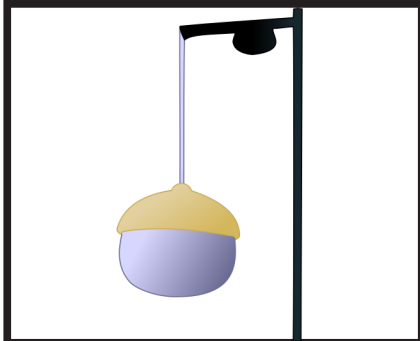
This bike was used to escape for safety. What is the full story?



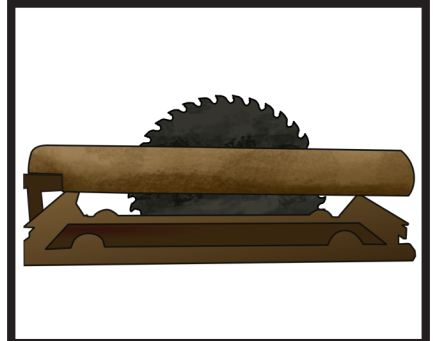
Who were the ones that wore this symbol?



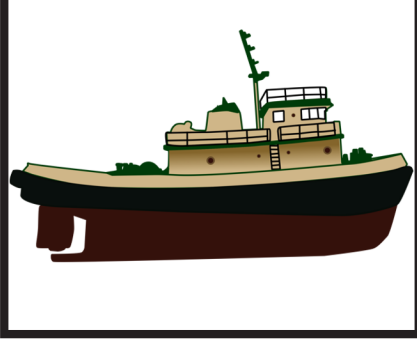
What is the shape of this lamp?



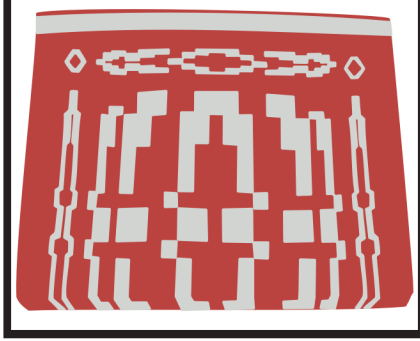
Why would a sawmill be invented in Washington?
